REPORT OF FEEDBACK FROM STUDENTS AND ALUMNI (2018-19)

Indira Gandhi Institute of Development Research (IGIDR) has a regular practice of collecting the feedback from students and alumni to obtain the views on set parameters, analyse the same and adopt corrective/remedial measures where deemed appropriate.

The findings from the analysis of the feedback are as follows:

- 1. A large majority of students and alumni consider the programme content to be excellent.
- Students and alumni expressed their satisfaction (ranging from 'very good' to 'excellent') with the resources available for learning and research, programme outcomes, and the relevance of the programme for job placements.
- 3. Students and alumni had high opinions on the relevance of courses, the evaluation process and fairness with students .
- 4. Existing students expressed very good opinion about appropriateness of syllabus, time allocated for courses, sequence of units, development of analytical and formulation ability and the overall relevance of the program.
- 5. In the opinion of students, the syllabus is very good in development of appropriate skills required in profession.
- 6. 92% of respondent alumni expressed their readiness to collaborate with the institute.
- 7. Some alumni expressed the need for internship abroad with scholarship.



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ACTION TAKEN REPORT ON THE FEEDBACK FROM STUDENTS AND ALUMNI (2018-19)
