

Action Taken Report on Recommendations of IQAC Meeting dated December 28, 2021

I. Agenda Item 3: Discussion of quality initiatives for the year 2022

The IQAC Coordinator invited members to suggest quality initiative for the year 2022. Some of the suggestions were as follows:

- (i) Interaction of current IGIDR students with IGIDR alumni members to learn about developments in the corporate sector.
- (ii) Exploring the use of various tools to enhance interaction and discussion during virtual lectures and presentations.
- (iii) Organising yoga and meditation classes for the students, faculty members, and staff as part of value added activities.

Action Taken:


- (i) Hosting the first edition of Corporate Colloquium. This is an initiative of the Placement Cell of IGIDR. The objective of this event is to provide students with an opportunity to gain a clearer understanding of the corporate world. The Institute will be hosting several industry leaders, each of whom has vast experience in dealing with the challenges of a corporate workforce. The students will have a chance to interact with them and learn what to expect from the ever-changing job market. In addition, the second season of Alumni Discourses has been initiated where IGIDR alumni are invited to speak about their own career trajectory, career prospects and life after IGIDR.
- (ii) Faculty are engaged in exploring different forms of virtual interaction. While online classes have resumed, different tools will be useful for virtual presentation in webinar and other online events.
- (iii) Yoga and meditation classes are being planned at present.

II. Agenda Item 4: Any other matter with the permission of the Chair.

It was suggested that to further build on the dissemination of information about the 19th Macroeconomics and Finance Conference to more than 4000 individuals and institutions, indexed videos of the conference proceedings as well as photographs be shared with all concerned.

Action Taken:

- (i) A YouTube Channel specific to the 19th Macroeconomics and Finance Conference () has been created where video recordings of all conference sessions have been posted day-wise. Indexing has also been done.
- (ii) Conference presentations have been uploaded on the conference webpage. The process of disseminating information of the video-recordings and other conference materials on the webpage, social media and through mailers is ongoing.
