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About the Institute

Indira Gandhi Institute of Development Research (IGIDR) is an advanced research institute established and fully funded by the Reserve Bank of India for carrying out research on development issues from a multi-disciplinary point of view. IGIDR was registered as an autonomous society on November 14, 1986 and as a public trust in January 1987. The Institute was recognized as a Deemed University under Section 3 of the UGC Act. Since then it has been awarded the highest National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) rating of A++ (under the old methodology) given to Indian academic institutions. Starting as a purely research institution, it rapidly developed into a full-fledged teaching cum research organisation when it launched a Ph.D. program in the field of development studies in 1990. The objective of the Ph.D. programme is to produce researchers with diverse disciplinary backgrounds who can address issues of economics, energy and environment policies. In 1995, the institute initiated the M. Phil programme and the M.Sc. programme in 2003.

Since 1987 IGIDR has been relentless in its pursuit of excellence in teaching, research, and consulting support to the industry. We are known for excellence in research and scholarship, global character, values, diversity and for the impact we make on multiple stakeholders in the society.

M.Sc PROGRAMME IN ECONOMICS

M.Sc is a two-year programme, which provides students with a rigorous and hands-on training in Economics, with special emphasis on analytical and problem solving skills as well as exposure to emerging policy issues at the national and international levels. This programme involves a successful completion of either 16 courses or 15 courses and a Master's thesis.

M.Phil IN DEVELOPMENT STUDIES

M.Phil is a two-year programme. The programme requires both successful completions of a minimum of 10 courses as well as submission of a dissertation.

Ph.D IN DEVELOPMENT STUDIES

In addition to a dissertation, the Ph.D programme includes extensive course work for two years. It is designed to instill scholars with the capacity to effectively utilize quantitative and interdisciplinary analysis to contribute to the understanding of national and global development issues.

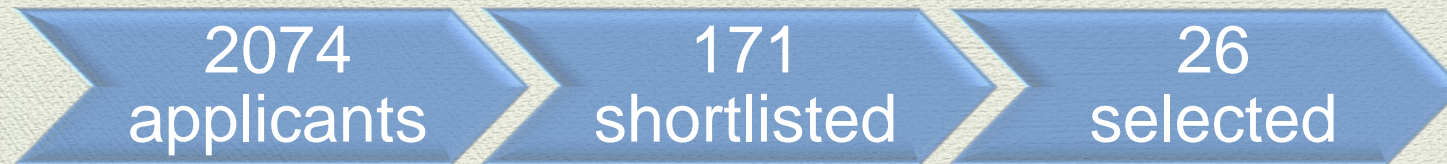

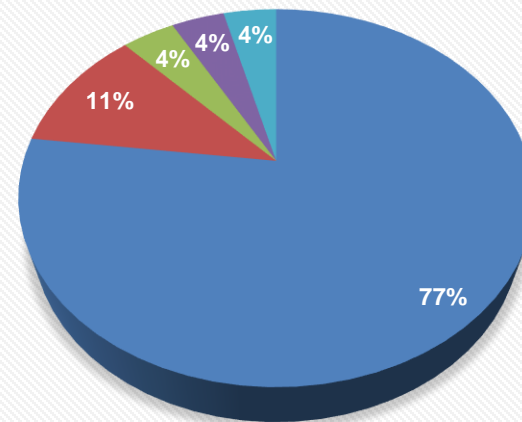

Some key skills gained through the Curriculum are:

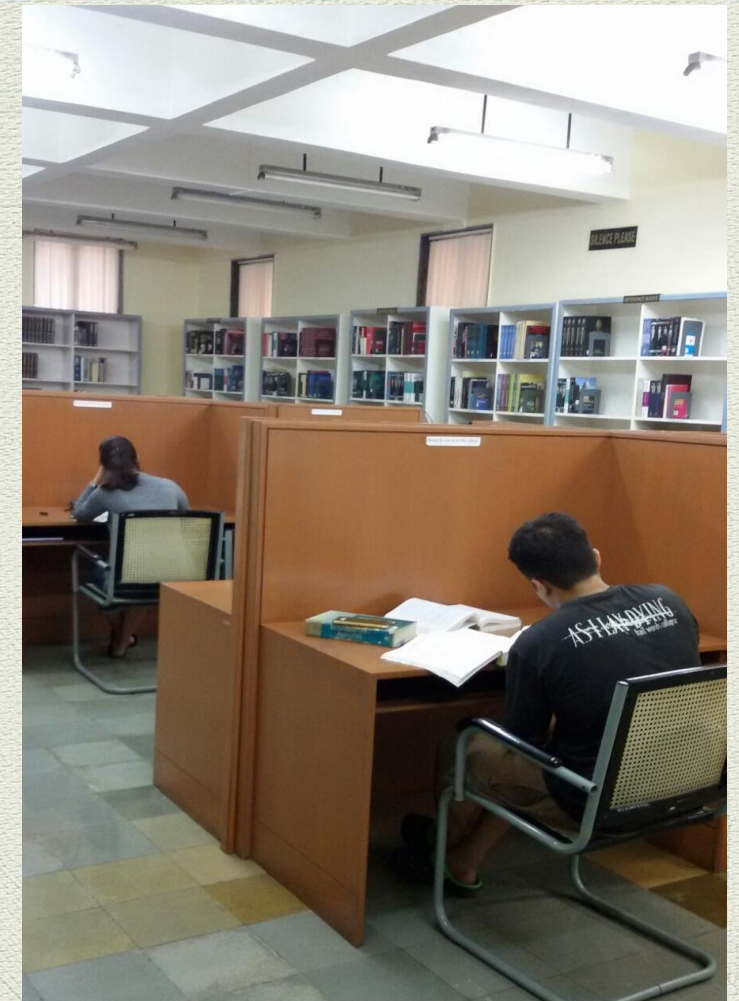
