- 1) The interviews for both the programmes on all the three days **will be online** and will begin at 9.00 a.m. sharp

Schedule of interviews:

22nd and 23rd October 2020 - M.Sc interviews

24th October 2020 – Ph.D. Interviews

- 2) In this scenario candidates would be required to have a computer/laptop with a camera and mic facility and a reliable internet connection to take interviews. A formal email to candidates regarding the interviews will be sent separately

For Online interviews, kindly note the following:

- i. All candidates are required to install the Zoom video conferencing software /App on their computer or mobile and get familiar with the zoom software a few days before the interview.
- ii. Your Internet connection / mobile data should be strong and reliable; a weak connection may cause freeze-ops and other problems. So, test your internet speed video calling zoom with some of your friends. If you do not have a good connection, then please go to a facility center/Internet Cafe where you have a good connection (Zoom recommends an internet speed of 1.5 megabits per second (mbps). If you plan to use Zoom at home, you can test your internet speed by going to <http://www.speedtest.net/>)
- iii. Your room should be well lit (proper lighting) so that you are clearly visible. Avoid having light sources behind you.
- iv. Use a good camera and headset (preferably a wired headset with mike) so that you are clearly audible and visible. While talking, look at the camera instead of looking at the other person on the screen.
- v. Choose an area or room which is quiet and free of distraction and has a clear background like the wall of the room. A room where you can shut the door is an ideal space to interview. Limit other noises by closing windows and turning off your music or the television. If you are using Mobile for the interview turn off the notification.
- vi. Connect the zoom meeting 10 minutes before your schedule time.
- vii. Give your full name in Zoom meeting with admission Registration No: Example Ravi Shankar Panda-54002768
- viii. Keep your personal identification card like Aadhar, PAN or any govt recognized ID for verification after you admitted to the Zoom meeting

Note: Before the interview, work with a friend or family member to ensure your camera and headphones are working properly and that the lighting is at its best. A day or two prior to the

interview, test the applications on your computer or phone with your friend or family member. Check that your computer works well as well as your lighting and background.

- 3) Ph.D. Candidates are required to email the reports from referees as per the referee names mentioned in the online application forms by 20th October. The referee reports may be emailed at referees@igidr.ac.in. Candidates will not be allowed to appear for the interview if the Institute does not receive the Referee reports by the due date.
- 4) The final List of selected and wait list candidates will be displayed on the website by end October 2020. **The Academic Session for Batch 2020 will begin from November 9, 2020. The classes for the courses will be conducted online.**
- 5) If selected for the Programme and if your results for the minimum qualifying examination are yet to be declared, you will be given a provisional admission that will be valid till **November 30, 2020**. Your admission will be confirmed only if (i) you secure the minimum required class/division/percentage marks in the qualifying degree examination as mentioned in our advertisement and (ii) your final result is communicated to us by November 30, 2020. Failure to meet any of these criteria will imply automatic disqualification from the Programme.
