Notification

(Percentage Equivalent of CGPA at IGIDR)

Whereas Indira Gandhi Institute of Development Research (IGIDR) started a Master of Science (MSc) in Economics programme since 2003 and awarded MSc (Economics) degree since 2005.

Whereas IGIDR has also enrolled and awarded Maser of Philosophy (MPhil)/Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in Development Studies to students who also have to complete certain coursework requirement towards partial fulfilment of their respective degrees.

Whereas IGIDR has been receiving queries on percentage equivalent of Cumulative Grade Point average (CGPA) indicated in the Grade Sheets/Transcripts provided to its students.

Whereas IGIDR's system of evaluation for each course is based on letter grades that have an associated grade point and a range of percentage equivalent (see Table below).

System of Evaluation at IGIDR

Whereas a minimum grade point of 2.00 (C Only) is required for each course and a minimum CGPA of 2.25 from sixteen courses (or its equivalent) is required for award of MSc (Economics) degree at the end of the programme.

Whereas a minimum grade point requirement for each course and a minimum CGPA from the overall coursework requirement towards partial fulfilment of MPhil/PhD is as per prevalent rules.

This is to notify and inform that IGIDR does not provide a percentage equivalent of CGPA indicated in the Grade Sheets/Transcripts provided to its MSc or MPhil/PhD students.
