2nd Addendum to "Selection Criteria as per Approved Minutes of Expert Panellists Meeting to select Students for IGIDR's MSc and PhD Programmes in 2022"

(09 September 2022)

On the Addendum of 19 August 2022 the following clarification is given to #1.

1. Concession is given at the time of (a) application (as per eligibility criteria and reservation policy given in Prospectus), (b) calling for an interview (as per #3 of the selection criteria to shortlist applicants for interview, see here for MSc, and here for PhD), and (c) at the final selection (as per #9 of the approved minutes of expert panellists meeting). On (c), the cut-off for merit/wait list is based on the average normalized score greater than -1.00 for unreserved/open, Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) and Other Backward Classes-Non-Creamy Layer (OBC-NCL) and greater than -1.29 (rounded off to two decimals) for Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe, and People with Disabilities (PwD) for the MSc programme, and an average normalized score greater than zero (0) for the PhD programme. A stricter criterion was taken for PhD. However, note that the last candidate in the merit/wait list for unreserved/open, EWS or OBC-NCL for PhD has an average normalized score that is greater than 0.41. The calculation of the average normalized score has been explained in #2-#6 points of the approved minutes.

The other points in the <u>Addendum</u> of 19 August 2022 remain the same.
