Rank Card and Preparation of Merit Lists

- The programme-specific rank card for those who appeared in the interviews for Admission 2023 of IGIDR to its MSc in Economics and PhD in Development Studies programmes can be downloaded by the candidates from the <u>admission portal</u> by logging in with their user ID and password that they used for submitting their application. To guard against possible discrimination, candidates are to desist from asking rank, score or caste of other candidates, and, are requested to not share their rank or score in public domain.
- 2) The <u>first merit list</u> for Admission 2023 of IGIDR to its MSc in Economics and PhD in Development Studies programmes has already been published on 09 August 2023.
- 3) The programme-specific merit lists are based on ranks obtained from the weighted average normalized score (WANS) with 70% weight for the normalized written score of those who appeared in the interview (NWS) and 30% weight for the double normalized interview score (DNIS), as indicated in the <u>selection procedure</u> (see #8, page 2) published on 20 April 2023.
- 4) In preparation of merit lists, reservation as per statutory requirement and as indicated in the <u>prospectus</u> (page 3) has been followed. As indicated in the <u>selection procedure</u> (see #8b, page 2), the merit list for each programme has been prepared first for the open or unreserved category including all candidates who appeared for the interview for that programme and then for each category of candidates with vertical or horizontal reservation after excluding those in the first merit list of the open category.
- 5) Category-wise number of seats, number shortlisted for interview, number appeared for interview, number in the first merit list across programmes is given in Table 1.

Note: EWS is Economically Weaker Sections, GEN is General (the number shortlisted/appeared is General, but for Merit list it is open or unreserved). OBC-NCL is Other Backward Classes (Non-Creamy Layer), PwD is People with Disability. SC is Scheduled Caste, ST is Scheduled Tribe. OBC-NCL-PwD being a horizontal category, as the candidate shortlisted did not appear for the interview, the seat has been included under OBC-NCL in the merit list.

6) If there are vacancies, the second and third merit lists are scheduled to be released on 18 August 2023 and 25 August 2023, respectively. If there are further vacancies, the institute may come up with additional merit lists, but not beyond September 2023 (i.e. not beyond one month after the start of the classes, which is scheduled to start from 28 August 2023).
