

Admissions 2023 of IGIDR: Criteria to Shortlist for Interview

The applicants shortlisted for the interview based on the entrance test results are as per the following criteria.

Eligibility Criteria (Benchmark score)

An applicant has to score the benchmark score indicated in Table 1 at the Aggregate level and in Basic Mathematics as per category and as per programme to be eligible for being shortlisted for interview.

Category-wise Number Limits

In each programme, under each category of applicants, four times the number of seats for that category is shortlisted for the interview if they satisfy eligibility criteria indicated in Table 1. From those shortlisted for the interview, the last rank and the marks for that rank in the aggregate for that category are indicated for both the programmes in Table 2.
